Reasons why you might be interested in helping create a new community council serving the Genesee and Genesee Hill neighborhoods:

1. This portion of West Seattle presently has no community representation;
2. This Genesee Hill school is now vacant and the property could be sold;
3. Community councils have a historic voice in the discussion of what to do with excess School District property;
4. With the coming developments in the Junction and Triangle (Fauntleroy-Alaska-35th Huling Property blocks) areas, Genesee-area residents won't have much of a voice without a community council sounding board;
5. This area of West Seattle is on the list of areas where parks are sparse, a community council can advocate for Parks Levy funds to provide new parks purchases;
6. A community council can help provide cohesion to an area and can help with neighborhood block watches and community policing.
