

- 1. Maintain drainage (pipes, ditches, etc.)
- 2. Perform periodic inspections of property (before winter and during storms)
- 3. Check weep holes on walls.
- 4. Be alert during and following storms.
- 5. If you have an irrigation system, shut it off and check it out seasonally.
- 6. Keep fill and yard waste off slopes.
- 7. Leave stumps in the ground.
- 8. Call a professional, if you have questions or a problem!

- 1. Don't put fill on a steep slope.
- 2. Don't concentrate water on a slope.
- 3. Don't denude vegetation on slope without a re-vegetation plan.
- 4. Don't cut into the toe of a slope.
- 5. Don't remove tree stumps.
- 6. Don't place yard debris on steep slopes.
- 7. Don't install a permanent irrigation system in landslide-prone areas.
