- 1. Huling is party to an Asset Purchase and Sale Agreement ("Agreement") dated July 18, 2006. Gee is party to the Agreement by way of an Assignment and Assumption of Agreement dated on or around January 5, 2007.
- 2. Section 18.17 of the Agreement contains a binding arbitration clause that provides in pertinent part: "If a dispute arises between the parties concerning the provisions of this Agreement and such dispute does not involve a claim for equitable relief, and as a condition precedent to suit or action thereon, the dispute shall be submitted to arbitration." Gee's complaint no longer includes a claim for equitable relief as a result of this Court's November 21, 2008 Order Granting Defendants' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment dismissing Gee's claim for rescission.
- 3. The parties have agreed to initiate private arbitration proceedings to resolve the claims asserted in Gee's complaint and Huling's counterclaim.
- 4. In light of the foregoing, the parties agree that all proceedings in the abovecaptioned matter should be stayed pending the outcome of the arbitration.
