Magnuson Park for the people of Seattle to enjoy; 10 WHEREAS, Ms. Williams, while a member of the Seattle City Council, was the primary figure 11 in procuring the funding necessary to build a high-level bridge across the Duwamish 12 waterway; and 13 WHEREAS, the high-level bridge across the Duwamish waterway, commonly known as the "West Seattle Bridge," connecting West Seattle directly with SR 99 and with I-5 via 14 Spokane Street, provides significant benefits to Seattle residents; and 15 WHEREAS, the City Council seeks to acknowledge Ms. Williams' service to the community 16 and importance in making the high-level West Seattle Bridge a reality; NOW THEREFORE, 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATTLE, THE **MAYOR CONCURRING:** 19 Section 1. The high-level fixed span bridge portion of the West Seattle Freeway, which 20 21 is currently named the "West Seattle Bridge", shall have a secondary designation as the "Jeanette 22 Williams Memorial Bridge." 23 Section 2. The Council requests that the Seattle Department of Transportation place 24 memorial signs at prominent and appropriate locations which shall reflect the "Jeanette Williams 25 Memorial Bridge" designation. 26 27
