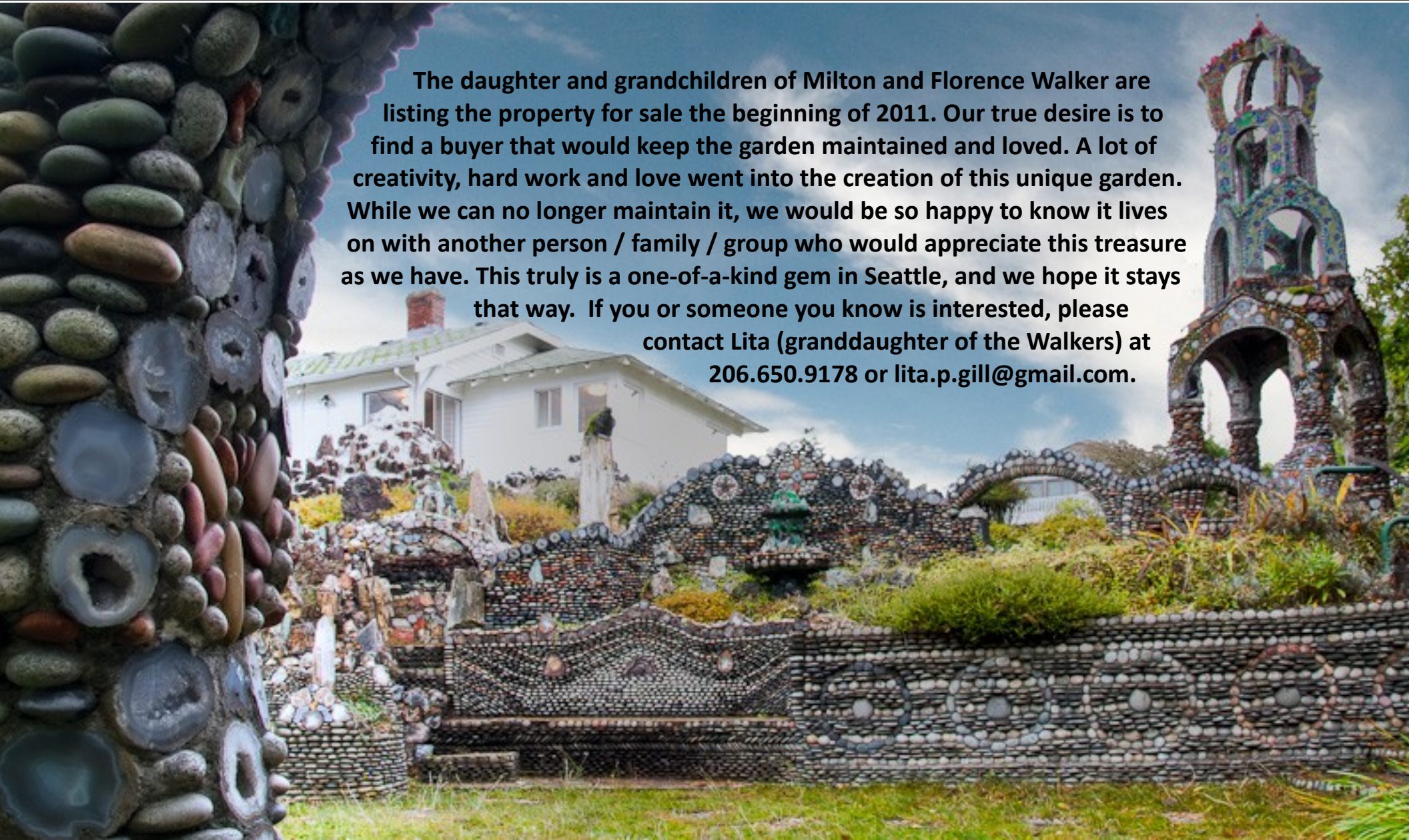


West Seattle Walker Rock Garden & Residence For Sale
