# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

SW Cloverdale Street Sidewalk Project
Late September to Late October 2011



### What to Expect During Construction:

- Temporary driveway closures
- Parking restrictions
- Traffic / pedestrian detours
- Moderate construction noise and dust
- Tree trimming and removal
- Normal work hours will be 7 a.m. 4 p.m., M-F

### Construction Starting the Week of September 26th, 2011

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will be constructing a new sidewalk and other pedestrian improvements on SW Cloverdale Street. Work is scheduled to begin on 9/26/11 and is expected to be completed by mid-to-late October, weather permitting.

This project is part of the "**Bridging the Gap**" transportation levy approved by Seattle voters in November 2006.

#### Project area

The new sidewalk will be on the south side of SW Cloverdale Street between 8th Avenue SW and 9th Avenue SW.

#### **Project elements**

- A new sidewalk with planting strip in some locations
- ADA compliant wheelchair ramps at all four corners of 9<sup>th</sup> Ave SW and SW Cloverdale St
- Rebuilding portions of some driveways to smoothly connect to the new sidewalk
- Relocating the marked crosswalk at 9<sup>th</sup> Ave SW & SW Cloverdale St to the south side of the street
- Street trees and grass seed where possible
- Artwork embedded in the new sidewalk
