At the age of 17 Rachel was in a rollover car accident. Her back was broken in 4 places and she severed 70% of her spinal cord. She was rushed into emergency surgery to save her life. Doctors told her she would never walk again. Rachel had other plans... In March 2011 she had invasive surgery using her own stem cells to repair her spinal cord. Shortly after, she found an organization called Project Walk in San Diego, CA. In less than 6 months of therapy she has gained strength and mobility back that she was told was impossible.

Unfortunately, this is considered "an unnecessary form of therapy" therefore it is not covered by her insurance. Rachel had to cancel her future appointments at Project Walk due to a lack of funds. Making a miracle isn't easy but there is strength in numbers and strength is what is going to get her back on her feet.
