On-street parking changes coming to SW Alaska St

Parking lots and off-street alternatives are available

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT), in partnership with King County Metro, is making street improvements in West Seattle to create a faster, more reliable corridor for Metro's new RapidRide buses. The RapidRide C Line will start operating in West Seattle later this year.

Several sections of existing on-street parking along SW Alaska St will be removed in May to accommodate the installation of a Business and Access Transit (BAT) lane. The BAT lane will help improve transit flow and support a service that will be more reliable and efficient.

The affected areas are on the northern and southern sides of SW Alaska St from California Ave SW to 35th Ave SW. Drivers are encouraged to utilize the off-street parking options available in the area, including garages and parking lots.
