



**Scheduled maintenance at Murray Pump Station
Lowman Beach Park
Tuesday, May 9
9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.**

King County Wastewater Treatment Division will carry out a scheduled maintenance operation at the county's Murray Pump Station, located at 7015 Beach Drive SW in Lowman Beach Park, on Tuesday May 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. King County and Seattle City Light will be testing power cables to the pump station. This test requires power shutdown at the pump station and the use of a temporary generator to ensure continuous operation of the wastewater conveyance system. A permanent emergency generator is planned as part of the Murray Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project, scheduled for completion in 2015.

The test is weather-dependent so it is subject to cancellation or rescheduling.

What to Expect

- Noise from temporary generator during scheduled power outage.
- Crews and equipment will be on site from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Lowman Beach Park will remain open.
- Traffic will be able to travel past the work area; however, drivers are advised to proceed with caution.
