Meet the Hunts...

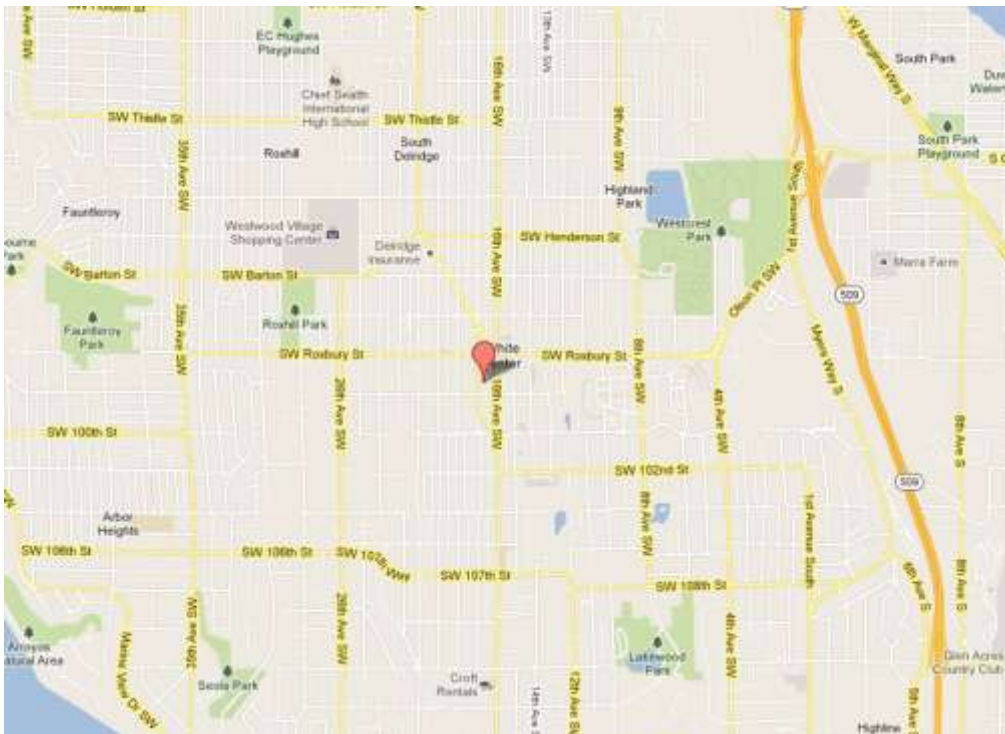
