

Public CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

September 9, 2014 Seismic retrofit on West Seattle Reservoir

PROJECT

Seattle Public Utilities is making improvements to the walls and floor of the West Seattle Reservoir, located in the northwest corner of Westcrest Park. This work will reduce the risk of cracking and leaks during a massive earthquake.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The project will reinforce the four corners of the reservoir with steel reinforcement and concrete. All work will occur inside the reservoir and will not require excavation.

SCHEDULE

September 2014 to March 2015

LOCATION

Crews, materials and equipment will enter the reservoir through existing access points in Westcrest Park. Materials will be temporarily stored near the access points.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

Because Seattle Parks and Recreation is currently working in the same area, this project's impacts will be minimal. However, you can expect:

- Increased truck and construction vehicle traffic on 8th Ave. SW, SW Cloverdale St. and SW Henderson St.
- Truck and equipment parking near reservoir access points.
- Construction noise.

There will be no impacts to water service, water quality or utility rates.
