- 1. Crowd behavior during the summer months (juvenile drinking)
- 2. Unsafe driving along Alki Ave SW
- 3. Parking issues along Alki

Strategies to address these concerns:

- 1. Crowd behavior during the summer months (juvenile fights)
 - a. Establish bicycle patrol along Alki.
 - b. Continue summer emphasis patrol on Friday and Saturday during school summer break.
 - c. Obtain the use of a mobile precinct for visible presence during the day.
 - d. 3rd watch patrol to close and empty park area as available.
 - 1. New larger park closed signs for the beach area.
 - e. New parking signs at the Don Armeni boat ramp.
- 2. Unsafe driving along Alki Ave SW
 - a. Request periodic emphasis from the Traffic unit.
 - b. Explore the possibility of installing speed bumps in selected areas along Alki.
- 3. Parking issues along Alki
 - a. Periodic emphasis from the SW assigned Parking Enforcement Officers.
 - b. Alki assigned bicycle and emphasis officers to monitor and cite as needed.
