

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Night work on ferry dock to clean sewer and storm main lines

PROJECT

Seattle Public Utilities' (SPU's) contractor Bravo Environmental will perform night work to clean sewer and storm main lines, located on the Fauntleroy ferry dock terminal.

DESCRIPTION

Crews will use jet trucks, water tankers, hoses and other heavy equipment to clean and clear debris from the sewer and storm main lines.

SCHEDULE

Crews will begin work on Friday, January 2, and are expected to be done by Friday, January 16, 2015. Work will begin at 9 pm each night and end by 5 am.

LOCATION

Work will be performed on the ferry dock terminal located at SW Barton Street and Fauntleroy Way SW (4829 SW Barton Street).

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Noise: There will be noise at night from utility trucks and equipment used to clean the sewer and storm main lines.
- Ferry Lane Restriction: About 100 feet of the north ferry loading lane will be coned off for staging cleaning equipment. Motorist will be directed around this staging area.
