March 17, 2015 Intermittent delays on SW Barton Place at 22nd Avenue SW

INTERMITTENT DELAYS MARCH 19, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.

On Thursday, March 19, from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m., traffic on SW Barton Place at 22nd Avenue SW will be stopped intermittently for five-minute intervals to allow for delivery of materials. A flagger will be on site to direct traffic.

DRIVEWAY IMPACTS

During these intermittent stops, access to driveways that connect to 22nd Avenue SW will be temporarily restricted for five minutes at a time.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) is retrofitting CSO 3, a combined sewer overflow (CSO) facility in your neighborhood. CSO 3 holds excess untreated stormwater and sewage during heavy rainstorms, and releases it once there is

capacity in the downstream system. The current tank design is inefficient. SPU's improvements will increase the efficiency of CSO 3, reducing overflows of untreated stormwater and sewage into Longfellow Creek. These improvements include installing a new underground diversion structure at the intersection of SW Barton Place and SW Barton Street.
