Full street closure to occur to fix sewer main on 22nd Avenue SW

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) crews will perform emergency repair work on 22nd Avenue SW at SW Andover Street to fix a broken sewer line. In order to perform this work, crews will need to fully close 22nd Avenue SW (see below).

<u>During construction, access will be limited to emergency vehicles only.</u>

Detour routes will also be in place for motorists traveling along SW Andover Street, Delridge Way SW, and 21st Avenue SW.

SCHEDULE

Work is expected to begin **Sunday, January 10 at around 6 p.m. Work will occur from 6 pm. to 7 a.m.** to minimize daytime traffic disruptions. Work will likely be completed Monday, January 11 at 7 a.m. One additional night of work may be needed.

Residents parked in the construction area will <u>not</u> be able to access their vehicles for travel during these work hours.

LOCATION

Work will take place at the intersection of 22nd Avenue SW and SW Andover Street, and along 22nd Avenue SW both north and south of Andover Street.



ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

- Full street closure with emergency vehicle access only during construction hours.
- Detours for motorists traveling in the area.
- Construction noise, dust and vibrations at night.
- Parking restrictions.
- Pavement excavation and restoration.
