CONSTRUCTION NOTICE



Construction at 30th Ave SW and SW Avalon Way to begin as soon as Monday, March 28

As soon as Monday, March 28, crews working for the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will begin constructing pedestrian safety improvements at the intersections of 30th Ave SW with SW Avalon Way and SW Avalon Way with SW Andover and SW Yancy streets. We expect construction will last approximately 6 weeks, depending on the weather.

Crews plan to start with building curb ramps on the west side of SW Avalon Way. This work will require the temporary closure of SW Andover St at SW Avalon Way for approximately three weeks, depending on weather. Local access will be maintained from 32nd Ave SW.


After completing work on the west side of SW Avalon Way, crews plan to build curb ramps and a curb extension at the intersection of SW Avalon Way with 30th Ave SW. During this work, crews will temporarily close SW Yancy St and 30th Ave SW at SW Avalon Way for approximately three weeks. Local access will be maintained from SW Genesee St. The duration of this closure is also weather dependent.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Temporary, rotating closure of side streets.
- Local access maintained at all times.
- King County Metro routes will not be impacted.
- Short-term sidewalk detours and on-street parking restrictions. People following the sidewalk detours will not need to cross SW Avalon Way.
- Temporary closure of bike lanes on SW Avalon Way.
 People riding bikes will be directed to merge with vehicle traffic.
- Noise, dust, and vibration.
- Weekday work hours, 7 AM to 5 PM.
