
## Repairs to sewer line on 50th Avenue SW

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) will be making repairs to a sewer line on 50th Avenue SW. The mainline at this location is damaged and requires replacement. Homes and businesses will continue to receive normal sewer services while the pipe segments are being repaired. In order to repair the sewer, water services may be disrupted. If your water service will be impacted you will receive a separate notice.

## **SCHEDULE**

Work is scheduled to begin the week of July 25. We anticipate the repair will take two weeks to complete, but weather may extend the schedule. Regular work hours are Monday through Thursday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.





#### ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

Homes and businesses will continue to receive normal sewer services while the new pipe is being installed. However, you can expect:

- Temporary lane closures.
- Temporary parking restrictions.
- Increased construction traffic, noise, dirt and vibrations.
- Ground and pavement excavation and restoration.
- Possible disruption of water services
