

Public NOTICE OF UPCOMING WORK

July 14, 2016

Repairs to sewer line on 46th Avenue SW

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) will be making repairs to a sewer line on 46th Avenue SW. The mainline at this location is damaged and requires replacement. Homes and businesses will continue to receive normal sewer services while the pipe segments are being repaired. In order to repair the sewer, water services may be disrupted. If your water service will be impacted you will receive a separate notice.

SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled to begin the week of July 18. We anticipate the repair will take three weeks to complete, but weather may extend the schedule. After the work is complete, a steel plate will cover the repairs until the contractor returns to restore the pavement. Regular work hours are Monday through Thursday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Two locations along 46th Avenue SW, north of SW Hudson Street. See map for specific locations.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

Homes and businesses will continue to receive normal sewer services while the new pipe is being installed. However, you can expect:

- Limited access to driveways during construction work hours.
- Temporary lane closures.
- Temporary parking restrictions.
- Increased construction traffic, noise, dirt and vibrations.
- Pavement excavation and restoration.
- Potential disruption of water services
