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PROJECT OVERVIEW AND BENEFITS

Seattle City Light plans to maintain electrical reliability in the Hillcrest Development by rebuilding parts of the underground system. The overall refurbishing of the system began in 2013. City Light must now return to complete the next phase of the project. The work is scheduled to start in the first week of September 2016.

The work involves trenching for the installation of electrical conduit and vaults. The project is the next step in ultimately replacing the existing cables in the affected areas with new ones.

A map showing the three work areas and their sequence is on the back of this flier.

PROJECT IMPACTS

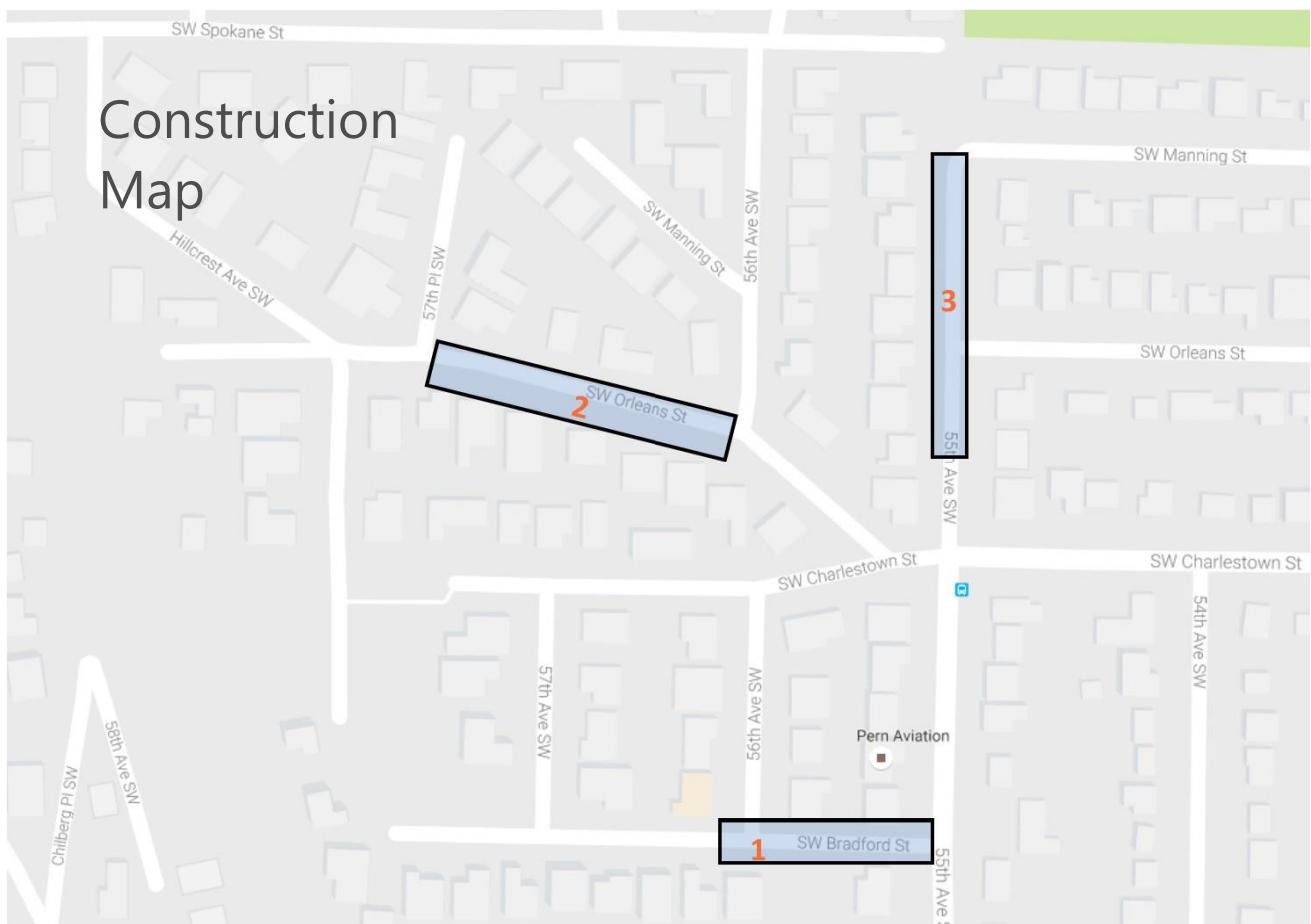
- Planned outages may be required. If required, customers will be notified in advance.
- Trenching will occur in the public right-of-way. Affected landscaping, sod, driveway aprons, and sidewalks will be restored to City standards.
- Parking restrictions are necessary to work safely/efficiently. Trenches will be plated at night.
- Once conduit and vault installation are complete, the electrical cable will be pulled into place.

PROJECT STAGES

- Trenching in the three sections of work for the conduit and vaults is planned from the first week of September 2016 through February 2017 and would follow the sequence shown on the map on the back of this flier.
- Installing the new electrical cable will occur between Jan – June 2017. This phase will not require trenching, but power outages will be necessary in the March-June 2017 timeframe. Customers will receive advanced notification with specific dates and times.



Trenching with vault and conduit installation is planned to begin the first week of September 2016 and be completed in February 2017.



TIMING AND COORDINATION

Schedule: Mondays-Fridays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., some weekend work may be necessary.

Construction Start: The start of construction is planned for the first week of September 2016.

Duration: This phase is expected to last through February 2017.
