15 INITIAL INCIDENT DESCRIPTION / NARRATIVE:

The following occurred in the City of Seattle, County of King, within the State of Washington. On October 2, 2018, I was working uniform patrol for the Seattle Police Department, in the City of Seattle. I was in full uniform, driving a fully marked patrol vehicle equipped with emergency lights and siren. I am currently assigned to patrol operations in William Sector, a district of the Southwest Precinct. On the afore mentioned date, I was working as assigned patrol unit 1-William -1. At approximately 1119 hours the 911 Communications Section received a call reporting a fight.

The call read as follows, " 3 MALES IN PHYSICAL WITH ONE OTHER MALE, NO WEAPONS"

While en route to the call the call, update read as follows, "M) ANOTHER REPORTING AN ADULT MALE IN A PHYS FIGHT WITH 3 TEENS, NO WPNS SEEN.

I arrived at California AV SW & SW Admiral WY SW. When I arrived on scene in front of the Wells Fargo, I was approached by Suspect/

who was later identified by his ID. When I arrived, he was yelling that he was assaulted and he had a head injury to his head with blood coming down his face. S/

wyelled at me several times for me to get his back pack back. I thought that this was strange behavior after someone has just been struck in the head with blood coming from his head. S/

was tated that he walked up to V/

and confronted him because V/

saying to his little bro. I asked him what was V/

saying to his little bro.

what is the heard V/

what is the name of his little bro, and S/

what is the name of his little bro, and S/

brown stated he didn't want to give his name. I thought that this was strange that he did not want to provide his brother's name if they all were assaulted.

V/ stated that he grabbed a rock that was nearby, while he was on the ground and hit S/ in the head with a rock to get the males away. V/ stated that he managed to get to his feet. He was swinging at others but was unsure if he hit them. He then told the males that he was going to his car to get his gun, because the males would not stop assaulting him. The males continued to advance on him. V/ then went to his vehicle and grabbed his firearm, raised it in the air and yelled at the males to leave him alone. V/ then placed the handgun into his rear pocket. S/ walked away. S/ remained on scene as V/ had his wallet and backpack. V/ told me the reason that he kept the items was so that S/ would stay on scene as he yelled at them "you all are going to jail" S/ was not on scene and was not located.

There were no witnesses that directly observed the event on scene that I could locate. I talked to the manager at Wells Fargo identified as Witness/ stated that he observed S/ and V/ arguing and he called 911 also. I asked if there was surveillance in the area, and he said there is and would provide it later because it takes a few days to obtain.

Seattle Fire Responded to the scene and treated S/ S/ S/ was transported to Harborview for further medical treatment.

Officer Perrotti followed AMR to Harborview and sat with S/ until the investigation was finished. Officer Daily 8407 replaced Officer Perrotti at the hospital.

V/More provided me with a statement that was captured on my Seattle Police Department issued voice recorder and uploaded to DEMS. V/More signed a sworn affirmation statement form. I photographed his injuries and uploaded to DEMS.

Seattle Fire treated V/ on scene. He had minor scratches and on his left and right elbow indicating that he was on the ground. V/ also had scratches on both knuckles and on his hands. I observed blood on his shirt and pants. While speaking to V/ he he complained of moderate back pain and pain to his side.

arrived on scene. Sub/ stated that a male later identified as Sus/ arrived back at school with an injured hand and scratch to his neck as well as Sus/ Sub/ asked for the descriptions of the males involved to see if they were the ones involved. I later went to the school and asked the Principal to have S/ and S/ come to the Office. S/ was not at the school and was scheduled to be in school. S/ was brought to the Office.

S/med had cuts to his lower neck area and several cuts to both hands. He was treated by the nurse when he arrived back at school. His right hand was bandaged up. Officer Constantin 8379 advised S/med of Miranda before speaking to him. He did not invoke his rights, and spoke to us.

S/ stated that V/ continued to get into the face of his friends, and took his friends backpack. S/ stated that after he heard V/ say he was going to get his gun he walked off.

S/2006 stated that V/2006 grabbed a rock and hit S/2006 Officer Constanin 8379 took a recorded audio statement from S/2006 and photographed his injuries.

- I screened the incident with YSC and they declined to take S/ and S/
- I screened the incident with A/SGT Bale 6783.
- I Interviewed and released S/Mark at West Seattle High. S/Mark was Interviewed and released from Harborview Medical Center.

S/W declined to give a statement. V/W positively Identified S/W through a field show up by Officer Eby 8498 at West Seattle High School.

S/Mark & S/Mark was provided with a business card with an incident number. V/Mark was provided with a business card with an incident number. I provided Sub/Mark with a business card with an incident number.
