The Seattle Housing Authority (SHA) purchased the Lam Bow apartments in 2002 as replacement housing for the redevelopment of High Point. In 2016 one of the two buildings caught fire and was demolished. SHA has been working on replacement of the lost units and exploring options for redeveloping the site to increase the number of units under the existing zoning. A second Early Design Guidance review process will be conducted by Seattle's Department of Construction and Inspection (SDCI) in the coming weeks. Once posted plans can be found on SDCI's website:

Redevelopment Goals:


- Replace units from North and South buildings and add units
- Provide 1 parking space for each unit (at-grade parking lot instead of underground parking)
- Units in both will be affordable (income-restricted) up to 60% of area median income
