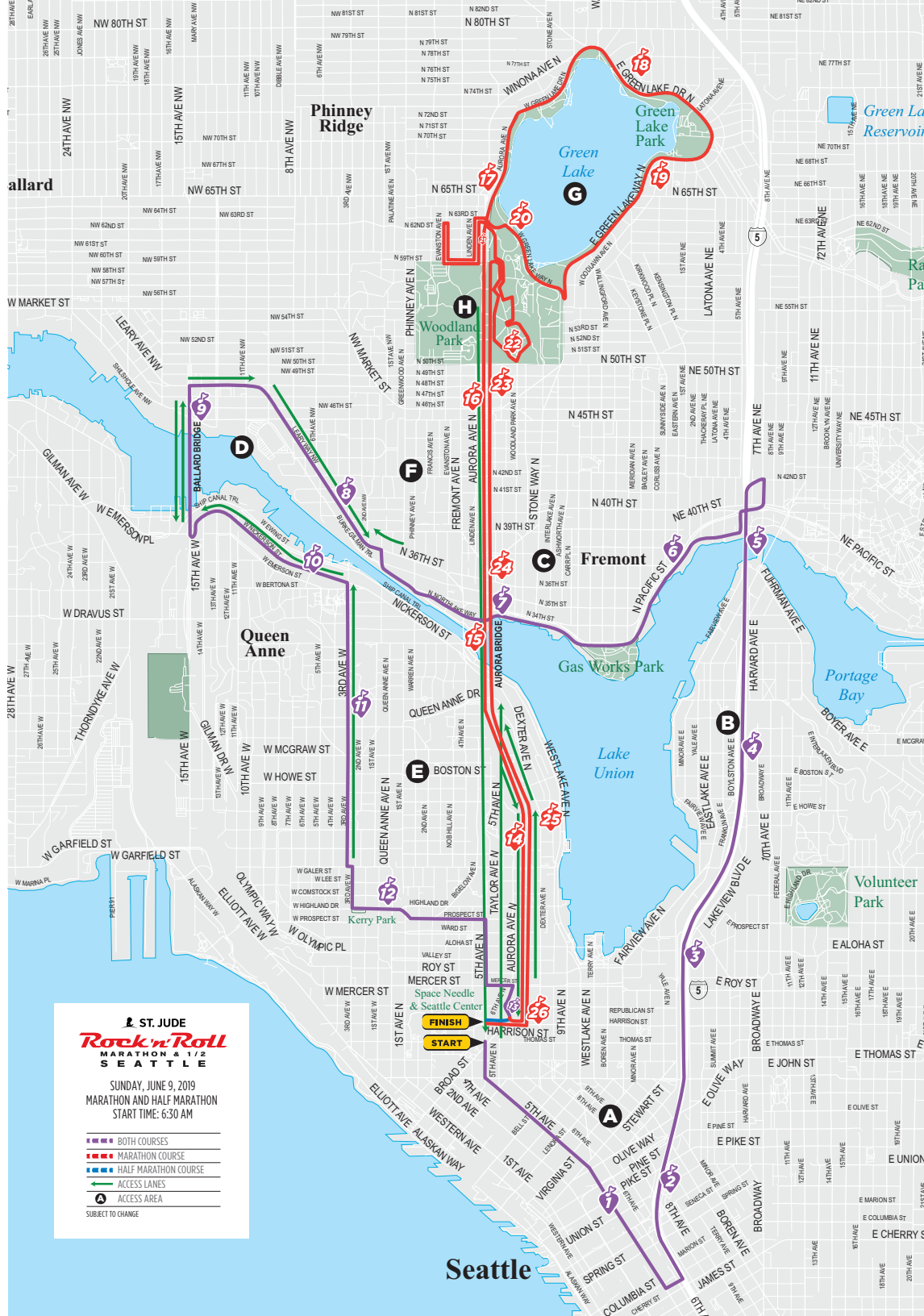

## ROAD CLOSURES - SUNDAY, JUNE 9, 2019

Roads will reopen as soon as the last runner has passed and course materials have been removed. At most points along the course, pedestrians and bicyclists may cross the course during safe gaps in runners. Please follow the discretion of a traffic controller if present.

<b>C</b>	Freemont	6:30am-9:45am	Westbound N Pacific St/N 34th St/N Northlake Way will remain open during the race
<b>D</b>	Ballard	6:30am-10:30am	Westbound N 36th St will remain open during the race Eastbound Leary St will remain open during the race Ballard Bridge to remain open in both directions during the race
<b>E</b>	Queen Anne	8:00am-11:30am	Northbound 3rd Ave will remain open during the race Westbound W Nickerson St will remain open with access to the Ballard Bridge (NB/SB access lanes on Ballard Bridge)
<b>F</b>	Northbound Aurora/99	6:00am-2:00pm	Southbound Aurora/99 will remain open during the race Northbound Aurora/99 access from Roy St to Halladay St Northbound access from 38th St to Green Lake Way N
<b>G</b>	Green Lake	7:30am-1:30pm	Northbound traffic will be allowed on SB W Green Lake Way N Counter clockwise vehicle access will be allowed on Greek Lake Drive during the race
<b>H</b>	Woodland Park	7:30am-2:00pm	Access Woodland Park Zoo via Phinney Ave There will be access to the 59th St parking lot via a westbound 59th St access lane
