ORDINANCE NO. 101203

AN ORDINANCE approving and confirming the assessment and assessment roll of Local Improvement District No. 6405 for the improvement of

SOUTHWEST BRACE POINT DRIVE from Fauntleroy Way Southwest to 46th Avenue Southwest; and certain other streets, avenues and easements;

by constructing underground utilities lines and a residential street lighting system;

under Ordinance No. 98120, and levying and assessing the amounts thereof against the several lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property as shown on said roll, establishing a Local Improvement Fund.

Be It Ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the assessment and assessment roll of Local Improvement District No. 6405 for the improvement of

SOUTHWEST BRACE POINT DRIVE from Fauntleroy Way Southwest to 46th Avenue Southwest; and certain other streets, avenues and easements;

by constructing underground utilities lines and a residential street lighting system all in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 144, Laws of 1957 and Chapter 119, Laws of 1967.

under Ordinance No. 98120, as the same now stands, be, and the same is, hereby in all things approved and confirmed.

Section 2. That each of the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property shown upon said roll is hereby declared to be specially benefited by said improvement in at least the amount charged against the same and that the assessment appearing against the same is in proportion to the several assessments appearing upon said roll. There is hereby levied and assessed against each such lot, tract, parcel of land and other property appearing upon said roll the amount finally charged against the same thereon.

Section 3. That for the purpose of this improvement, there is hereby created and established a special fund to be called "Local Improvement Fund, District No. 6405",

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
