Construction started June 2020 and is expected to continue through 2022.

REMINDER: Businesses along the corridor are open during this work. Please follow posted detour signs as you visit these businesses.

What to expect the week of August 31

We are currently working in all three zones at the same time, from north to south on Delridge Way SW. As our work zone shifts will see No Parking signs go up towards the southern of the work zone and parking restored in the northern end of the work zone.

In each of the three work zones, travel lanes will be generally be reduced to one lane in each direction with restricted turns and from time to time you may expect flaggers to be operating one lane at a time. Please follow posted traffic signs.

IMPORTANT: Upcoming closure on Delridge Way SW extended into Sunday, August 30

We will be closing all lanes of Delridge Way SW from SW Barton St to 18th Ave SW beginning tomorrow, August 29, 2020. The work will continue through August 30, 2020 to allow time for Seattle Public Utilities to complete additional work in the area.

Please expect:

- Delridge Way SW to be fully closed from SW Barton St to 18th Ave SW
- Local access only to be allowed from SW Henderson St to SW Barton St and 18th Ave to SW Roxbury St
- Restricted turns from side streets onto Delridge Way SW while the closure is in place
- Access to businesses to be maintained at all times

•	Traffic to be detoured to 16th Ave SW. Please see the map below for

Upcoming closures and major work

- Weekend work in the intersection at SW Orchard St and Delridge Way SW
 - Beginning today, Friday, August 28, we will be working through the weekend to install a catch basin near the middle of the intersection
 - There will be flaggers helping to redirect traffic around the work zone.
 Please plan accordingly and expect heavy traffic and delays.
- Major weekend street closures traffic detours between SW Henderson St and SW Roxbury St on Delridge Way SW
 - Please see the call-out box above

Ongoing closures and work

- Temporary driveway closures near SW Holden St and Delridge Way SW
 - Expect intermittent impacts to driveway access. Driveways will be covered with a steel plate when work is not occurring.
 - o We will work our way south towards SW Thistle St in the next few weeks
- Sidewalk closures and detours between Sylvan Way SW and SW Webster St
 - We are continuing to demolish and pour concrete at the sidewalks between Sylvan Way SW and SW Webster St
 - People walking will need to cross at the marked intersections at SW Myrtle St or SW Holden St. Please follow posted detour signs.
- Weekend pipework near the Longfellow Creek Greenspace for several weeks
 - We will remain in the area to connect underground pipes in the middle of the roadway. Please continue to expect construction activities in this area.
 - Left turns onto Delridge Way SW between SW Juneau St and SW Graham St will be restricted while we complete this work, though access to driveways will be maintained
 - This work may take place over several weekends. Please reach out to us if you have concerns about accessibility during this work and follow onsite signage.

Our schedule is subject to change. Please sign up for our text message updates by texting DELRIDGE to 33222 to receive the most up to date information on night work and closures.

New work by zone

- Zone A (West Seattle Bridge to SW Findlay St)
 - Work near SW Hudson St on the west side is nearly complete. Please expect this street to reopen to through traffic soon.
 - Demolition and paving work on Delridge Way SW (west side)
 - We have begun pouring concrete on the west side between SW Dakota St and SW Genesee St, and between SW Alaska St and SW Edmunds St

- This work will be completed early next week and people driving will be moved to the west side of Delridge Way SW to allow us to begin working on the east side of the street
- Continued demolition and paving work on Delridge Way SW (east side)
 - We have begun demolishing the roadway on the east side of Delridge Way SW in Zone A
 - We are continuing to demolish the roadway between SW Alaska St and SW Oregon St.
 - Next week, we will begin demolishing the roadway between
 SW Oregon St and SW Genesee St. This will work will last into the following week.
 - This work will be loud. You can expect hammering, dust, and vibrations during this work.
 - Driveways on the east side of Delridge Way SW in this area will be temporarily impacted while we complete this work
 - Please continue reading below for information on driveway impacts
 - Throughout mid-September, we will be paving the roadway throughout Zone A as we complete demolition work. Please follow signed detours and updated traffic patterns.
- Continued underground utility work between SW Hudson St and Puget Blvd
 SW
 - This work will last through mid-September
 - You can expect construction impacts similar to other underground utility work in the area
- Zone B (SW Findlay St to north of SW Orchard St)
 - We will continue demolishing the sidewalk between Sylvan Place SW and SW Webster St on the west side of the street. This work will continue through mid-September.
 - Please follow posted detour signs at SW Myrtle St
 - Trees with white markings along the corridor will be removed
- Zone C
 - Starting this week, we will be removing some trees in Zone C
 - For every tree that will be removed as a part of this project, we will plant 2 trees to replace it
 - For the next several weeks, we will continue demolishing the sidewalk on the west side of the street between SW Thistle St and SW Trenton St
 - In mid-September, we will move to the east side of the street to complete similar work

What to expect during paving

As we begin paving near residential properties, you may experience impacts to your driveway as we demolish and restore the roadway in front of your property. During this work, you can expect:

- Temporary access restrictions in and out of driveways on Delridge Way SW during active demolition. Demolition work is usually limited to a few hours.
- Loud hammering, dust and vibrations
- During active demolition, onsite crews will be able to provide access to emergency vehicles or for people leaving their homes for emergencies
- If you need your car in a timely manner, we recommend parking on side streets. Otherwise, please be prepared for delays and plan to connect with crews onsite to coordinate access.
- Steel plates or a gravel ramp will be placed to provide access to the driveways outside of active work hours
- Up to 3 days of driveway restrictions as concrete cures directly in front of your property. We will deliver notices to any properties with this impact.

Impacted properties will be notified in advance of this work occurring.

What to expect during construction


Generally, we anticipate working weekdays between 7 AM and 7 PM. Impacts will include:

- Noise, dust, and large vehicle traffic
- Temporary construction parking restrictions for weeks at a time
- Periodic traffic detours
- Vehicle lane shifts around work zones
- Temporary utility service impacts
- Flaggers to help direct traffic
- Temporary bus detours and bus stop relocations



As part of this project, we will be upgrading the road condition throughout the corridor. You can expect roadway demolition to look like the photo above.
