Construction started June 2020 and is expected to continue through 2022.

REMINDER: Businesses along the corridor are open during this work. Please follow posted detour signs as you visit these businesses.

What to expect the week of September 14

We are currently working in all three zones at the same time, from north to south on Delridge Way SW. As our work zones shift you will see No Parking signs go up towards the southern end of the work zone and parking restored in the northern end of the work zone.

In each of the three work zones, travel lanes will be generally be reduced to one lane in each direction with restricted turns and from time to time you may expect flaggers to be operating one lane at a time. Please follow posted traffic signs.

Upcoming closures and major work

- Temporary access restrictions near Longfellow Creek Green Space
 - Starting Monday September 14, neighborhood access will be temporarily limited while we connect utilities at the 24th Ave SW and SW Graham St intersections for a week. Access will be maintained at all other times.
 - o Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times
- Upcoming major overnight pipework near SW Brandon St
 - On Monday September 14 and Tuesday September 15, we will be working at night on the east side of SW Brandon St and Delridge Way SW to install pipes in the roadway
 - Once nightwork is completed, we will continue working during regular hours in this area for several weeks
 - This work requires us to dig deep in the ground. Please anticipate noise, dust, and vibrations.
 - Night work hours are between 7 PM 6 AM
- Upcoming road closure at SW Oregon St and Delridge Way SW to complete paving
 - Weekend work is tentatively scheduled for the weekends of September 18-21 and September 25-28. Please note this work is weather-dependent and may change.

- Weekend work hours are from Friday morning through Monday morning
 We will share more information next week as we get closer to this work
- o People traveling on Delridge Way SW will still be able to travel north and south past this intersection
- People traveling to Delridge Way SW from the closed area will need to detour to SW Andover St via 21st Ave SW. Please refer to the detour map below for more details.

Ongoing closures and work

- Temporary driveway closures near SW Holden St and Delridge Way SW
 - Expect intermittent delays to driveway access. Driveways will be covered with a steel plate when work is not occurring.
 - o We will work our way south towards SW Thistle St in the next few weeks
- · Continued driveway impacts and closures during roadway demolition and paving
 - We are working our way south on Delridge Way SW to demolish and repave the roadway. We will notify properties in advance of driveway impacts.

Our schedule is subject to change. Please sign up for our text message updates by texting DELRIDGE to 33222 to receive the most up to date information on night work and closures.

New work by zone

- Zone A (West Seattle Bridge to SW Findlay St)
 - Paving on the west side of Delridge Way SW is complete
 - People driving will now be moved to the west side of Delridge Way SW to allow work to occur on the east side of the street
 - As we continue south, we will be switching back to the west side of Delridge Way SW in the coming months
- Continued demolition and paving work on Delridge Way SW (east side)
 - We are continuing to demolish and repave the roadway on the east side of Delridge Way SW in Zone A

- We are currently paving between SW Alaska St and SW Oregon St.
 Please anticipate driveway closures for up to a week.
- We will continue demolishing the roadway between SW Oregon
 St and SW Genesee St through this week and begin paving as soon as Thursday, September 17
- We will begin demolishing the roadway between SW Genesee
 St and SW Dakota St as soon as Thursday, September 17. Please expect intermittent driveway restrictions as this work is completed.
- This work will be loud. You can expect hammering, dust, and vibrations during this work.
- Driveways on the east side of Delridge Way SW in this area will be temporarily impacted while we complete this work
- Please continue reading below for information on driveway impacts
- Throughout mid-September, we will be paving the roadway throughout Zone A as we complete demolition work. Please follow signed detours and updated traffic patterns.
- Continued underground utility work between SW Hudson St and Puget Blvd SW
 - This work will last through mid-September
 - You can expect construction impacts similar to other underground utility work in the area
- **Zone B** (SW Findlay St to north of SW Orchard St)
 - Pipe work at SW Juneau St beginning as early as Monday September 28
 - Please expect loud noise, dust, and vibrations, and traffic to be shifted to one side of the road as we install a new water line
 - SW Juneau St will remain closed to thru-traffic on both sides of Delridge Way SW
 - We will share more information as we prepare to start this work
 - We will continue demolishing the sidewalk between Sylvan Place SW and SW
 Webster St on the west side of the street
 - Please follow posted detour signs at SW Myrtle St

Zone C

- For the next several weeks, we will continue demolishing the sidewalk on the west side of the street between SW Thistle St and SW Trenton St
 - In mid-September, we will move to the east side of the street to complete similar work
- Throughout Zone C, we will be locating underground utilities with potholes.
 Please travel safely around onsite crews as we complete this work.

What to expect during paving


As we begin paving near residential properties, you may experience impacts to your driveway as we demolish and restore the roadway in front of your property. During this work, you can expect:

- Temporary access restrictions in and out of driveways on Delridge Way SW during active demolition. Demolition work is usually limited to a few hours.
- Loud hammering, dust and vibrations
- During active demolition, onsite crews will be able to provide access to emergency vehicles or for people leaving their homes for emergencies
- If you need your car in a timely manner, we recommend parking on side streets.
 Otherwise, please be prepared for delays and plan to connect with crews onsite to coordinate access.
- Steel plates or a gravel ramp will be placed to provide access to the driveways outside of active work hour
- Up to 3 days of driveway restrictions as concrete cures directly in front of your property. We will deliver notices to any properties with this impact.
- Impacted properties will be notified in advance of this work occurring.

What to expect during construction


Generally, we anticipate working weekdays between 7 AM and 7 PM. Impacts will include:

- Noise, dust, and large vehicle traffic
- Temporary construction parking restrictions for weeks at a time
- Periodic traffic detours
- Vehicle lane shifts around work zones
- Temporary utility service impacts
- Flaggers to help direct traffic
- Temporary bus detours and bus stop relocations



As part of this project, we will be upgrading the road condition throughout the corridor. You can expect roadway demolition to look like the photo above.
