Construction started June 2020 and is expected to continue through 2022.

REMINDER: Businesses along the corridor are open during this work. Please follow posted detour signs as you visit these businesses.

What to expect the week of October 26

We are currently working in all three zones at the same time, from north to south on Delridge Way SW. As our work zones shift you will see No Parking signs go up towards the southern end of the work zone and parking restored in the northern end of the work zone.

In each of the three work zones, travel lanes will be generally be reduced to one lane in each direction with restricted turns and from time to time you may expect flaggers to be operating one lane at a time. Please follow posted traffic signs.

Upcoming closures and major work

TOMORROW: Weekend closure at SW Edmunds St

- SW Edmunds St will be closed on the east side of Delridge Way SW from Friday, October 23 at 9 AM to Monday, October 26 at 6 AM to complete demolition and paving work in the intersection
- If you have any concerns about accessibility during this work, please contact us via email or phone
- People wishing to access Delridge Way SW are encouraged to detour to SW Alaska St or SW Hudson St via Croft Pl SW
- Work directly on Delridge Way SW will continue into next week during regular working hours

Temporary street closure at SW Alaska St and Delridge Way SW

- Beginning Monday, October 26, we will be fully closing the east side of SW Alaska St at Delridge Way SW to rebuild the roadway
- This closure is expected to last through the end of next week. Please contact us if you have any concerns about accessibility during this work.
- People wishing to access Delridge Way SW are encouraged to detour to SW Edmunds St via Cottage Pl SW

- SW Alaska St will remain open while the weekend work at SW Edmunds St is completed
- Upcoming night work near SW Brandon St on Tuesday, October 27
 - We are scheduled to work overnight on October 27 in collaboration with Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) to complete underground pipework
 - SPU will coordinate timing and residents will be notified in advance of impacts to water service
 - Please contact Seattle Public Utilities' 24/7 service line at (206) 389-1800 if you experience any issues with your water service
 - This overnight work is scheduled to last one night
- Ongoing pipework and upcoming night work near SW Juneau St
 - We are scheduled to work overnight on Tuesday, November 3 to install pipes in the roadway
 - SPU will coordinate timing and residents will be notified in advance of impacts to water service
 - This work requires us to dig deep in the ground. Please anticipate noise, dust, and vibrations.
 - Driveways may be closed temporarily as crews complete this work. Residents will be notified in advance of any closures.
 - This work is expected to last for several weeks.
- Paving beginning between SW Alaska St and SW Edmunds St on the east side as early as Friday, October 23
 - As a reminder, driveways will be completely closed when concrete is being poured and while it dries during paving
 - Residents and businesses will be notified in advance if their access will be restricted
- Demolition and paving beginning in Zone B next week
 - We are now scheduled to begin work on the west side of Delridge Way SW between SW Graham St to 22nd Ave SW as early as Monday, October 26
 - When demolition in this area is completed, we will move between 22nd Ave SW and SW Holly St
 - Continue reading below for more details about this type of work

Ongoing closures and work

- Continued temporary driveway impacts and closures throughout Zones A, B, and C during roadway and sidewalk upgrades
 - Expect intermittent impacts to driveway access during demolition. Residents will be notified in advance of any driveway closures.
 - We will work our way south in each section and may flip sides on Delridge Way SW. Please continue reading for more details.

Anticipated schedule changes due to wet weather this year

This fall, we will continue demolishing and repaving the roadway, driveways and

sidewalks throughout the project corridor. Due to the wet weather, we may need to make last minute schedule changes to paving activities which may include delaying paving activities or starting concrete paving pours as the weather allows.

As a reminder, we aim to maintain access to driveways during demolition, which can last between 1 to 2 weeks in each area. If weather allows, paving will follow and typically require driveway closures for up to 1 week. Continue reading to learn more about our demolition and paving work zones and schedule.

Please plan for these schedule changes and reach out to us if you have any accessibility concerns during this work. You can learn more about typical paving impacts at the bottom of this email. Thank you for your patience during construction.

Our schedule is subject to change. Please sign up for our text message updates by texting DELRIDGE to 33222 to receive the most up to date information on night work and closures.

New work by zone

- Zone A (West Seattle Bridge to SW Findlay St)
 - Continued demolition and paving work on Delridge Way SW (east side)
 - Work is nearly complete between **SW Dakota St** and **SW Oregon St**. Curbs will be poured as soon as next week.

- Paving is scheduled to begin between SW Alaska St to SW Edmunds
 St this week and continue into next week
 - As a reminder, driveways will be completely closed when concrete is being poured during paving
 - Residents and businesses will be notified in advance if their access will be restricted
- Demolition between SW Edmunds St and SW Hudson St to begin this week
 - Demolition will last approximately one week. Access to driveways will be maintained during demolition and before paving.
 - We will notify residents of driveway closures before paving begins
- Demolition and paving between SW Hudson St and Puget Blvd SW to begin as early as October 29
 - Demolition is expected to last for approximately one wee
 - Paving is scheduled to begin as early as November 9.
 Driveways will be closed until paving is complete.
 - Residents and businesses will be notified in advance if their access will be restricted by this work
- **Zone B** (SW Findlay St to north of SW Orchard St)
 - Pipework will continue between 24th Ave SW and SW Myrtle St through mid-November
 - Roadway demolition and paving work to start in this section beginning next week
 - We will begin work on the west side of Delridge Way SW between SW
 Graham St to 22nd Ave SW and then move between 22nd Ave
 SW to SW Holly St
 - Travel to and from SW Graham St and 23rd Ave SW from Delridge Way
 SW will be restricted to local access only with one travel lane for traffic onto these neighborhood streets
 - Flaggers will be in the area to help control traffic

Zone C

- Duct bank work has resumed and will continue in this area for several weeks
- Tree removal to take place as early as October 29 throughout Zone C. These trees have been posted for removal.

What to expect during paving

As we begin paving near residential properties, you may experience impacts to your driveway as we demolish and restore the roadway in front of your property. During this work, you can expect:

- Temporary access restrictions in and out of driveways on Delridge Way SW during active demolition. Demolition work is usually limited to a few hours.
- Loud hammering, dust and vibrations
- During active demolition, onsite crews will be able to provide access to emergency vehicles or for people leaving their homes for emergencies
- If you need your car in a timely manner, we recommend parking on side streets.
 Otherwise, please be prepared for delays and plan to connect with crews onsite to coordinate access.
- Steel plates or a gravel ramp will be placed to provide access to the driveways outside of active work hour
- Up to **one week of driveway restrictions** as concrete cures directly in front of your property. We will deliver notices to any properties with this impact.
- Impacted properties will be notified in advance of this work occurring.

What to expect during construction


Generally, we anticipate working weekdays between 7 AM and 7 PM. Impacts will include:

- Noise, dust, and large vehicle traffic
- Temporary construction parking restrictions for weeks at a time
- Periodic traffic detours
- Vehicle lane shifts around work zones
- Temporary utility service impacts
- Flaggers to help direct traffic
- Temporary bus detours and bus stop relocations



As part of this project, we will be upgrading the roadway throughout the corridor. The roadway above has been fully demolished and is getting prepared for paving. Driveways will be closed as we repave the roadway. You can expect roadway demolition to look like the photo above.
