



NOTICE OF EMERGENCY WORK

SEPTEMBER 1, 2021

EMERGENCY SEWER MAINLINE REPAIR ON 44TH AVE SW NEAR SW COLLEGE ST

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) will repair a broken sewer mainline on 44th Ave SW just north of SW College St. The broken sewer pipe was discovered by a private side sewer contractor who notified the City of Seattle. The underground conditions (voiding) and upcoming construction activities require that 44th Ave SW to be closed to traffic until a repair can be made.

SCHEDULE

Work is expected to begin on or around September 8, 2021, and take up to two weeks to complete.

Work hours are Tuesday through Friday, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm

LOCATION

Center of 44th Ave SW from SW College St to about 100 feet north.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS

Homes and businesses will continue to receive normal sewer services while the new pipe is being installed. You can also expect:

- Temporary road and/or lane closures.
- Temporary parking restrictions.
- Increased construction traffic, noise, dirt, and vibrations.
- Pavement excavation and restoration.
