The *YMCA* and *King County Public Health* are partnering to provide vaccines and boosters in our community. Community members seeking 1st, 2nd, & 3rd (booster) vaccinations may attend this event.

The CDC and the Western States Scientific Safety Review Workgroup recommend everyone 12 years and older who received the Johnson & Johnson, Pfizer, or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine primary series to get a booster dose.

*Your eligibility for a booster vaccine (third dose) will be verified against the Washington State Immunization Information System, to ensure proper intervals in between doses have been met. The CDC has not yet authorized the fourth dose of COVID-19 vaccine at this time.

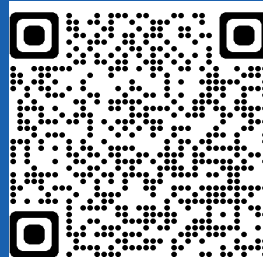

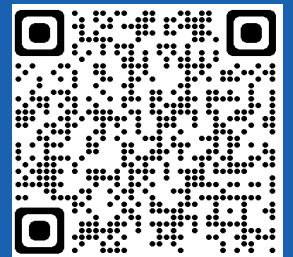
