

TOP PRIORITIES TO TACKLE CRIME, RVs & ENCAMPMENTS, AND DANGEROUS STREETS

Seattle Police Department

- 1) Strengthen overall response to crime
- 2) Continue and increase emphasis patrols
- Identify criminal encampments and respond appropriately
- 4) Crack down on neighborhood harassment by illegal campers
- 5) Prevention and enforcement for racing and stunt driving
- 6) Disperse after-hours crowds with consequences for illegal behavior

Seattle Department of Transportation & Parking Enforcement

- 1) Remove debris and garbage from our streets and parking strips
- 2) Install speed cushions & raised crosswalks from Jack Block Park to Alki/60th (resident input on placement)
- 3) Install "No Overnight Parking Except by Permit" signs on Harbor/Alki Aves
- 4) Install radar cameras for automatic ticketing of street racers
- 5) Convert Duwamish Head from diagonal to parallel parking
- 6) Set rental scooter/bike policy inoperable midnight until 5am, and eliminate excessive numbers

SPD + SDOT + PE: Ticket and remove illegally parked RVs, vans, trailers, trucks, and cars from city streets ASAP!

Seattle Parks & Recreation

- Enforce posted hours for Don Armeni and Seacrest parking lots: lock gates, ticket, and tow
- 2) Remove illegal encampments at Duwamish Head Greenspace (Harbor/Fairmount) and install "no camping" signs & permanent barriers
- 3) Begin regular inspections of park areas
- 4) Improve the method of ingress/egress at Don Armeni

Seattle City Council

- 1) Legislate a more effective city response to lawlessness: Investigate, arrest, jail, and prosecute criminals
- 2) Develop a place for encampments to go, with necessary services. End the shuffling cycle.
- Fund SPD, SDOT, and Parks at levels that enable them to do their jobs
