In 2022, Multi-Communities' services included: our 24/7 hotline, mobile advocacy and flexible financial assistance for survivors, trainings for peer responders and community leaders, outreach, as well as providing information and referrals.

Our volunteers contributed a combined total of 2,040 hours towards our goals of ending domestic and gender-based violence against Black girls and women while centering collective healing for our whole community.

Thru our partnerships with Westside Interfaith Network and Holgate Community Hot Meal Program, we provided food to over 350 homeless families.

Our long-term partnership with the Forgotten Children's Fund continues. We were able to provide holiday gifts for a total of 95 families with school age children. This program was supported by private community donors, the Windemere Foundation, Alki Congregational United Church of Christ, Journey Christian Home and other individual donors.

Families served included Martin Luther King Elementary School, Seattle World School, Washington Middle School, and Westside Head Start Program.
